

PONDEROSA SINGLES CLASSIC ~ TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entrants must show USBC membership or comply with USBC rule #300c.
2. **Bowler will use highest USBC/USBC Youth certified average from the 2009/2010 season. Bowlers with no certified average from previous season, use certified average of 21 games or more at the time of bowling. Those without an average bowler will bowl scratch, 230 average. Any bowler, who has competed in a certified SPORT LEAGUE or leagues we determine to be sport condition leagues, must use the U,S,B,C, Sport league adjustment chart in the rule book to establish their average used for handicap in this tournament.**
3. If current average of 21 games or more is 10 pins higher than last years, at the time you bowl, you must use your current average. USBC Rule 319a-2
4. You must report winnings over \$600.00 in any one event and actual scores bowled with the previous 12 month period. (attach separate sheet) Rule #319d is in effect.
5. National touring PBA/PWBA members are not eligible to compete in this tournament.
6. Re-rating: U.S.B.C. rule #319c and U.S.B.C. rule #319e is in effect.
7. If a breakdown of pin-spotters or automatic scorers occurs, we reserve the right to move bowlers to another pair of lanes to avoid shift delay.
8. Full time employees an not allowed to bowl in the tournament.
9. 5 games across 10 Lanes, Handicap 80% of 230 limited to 60 pins per game.
10. PRIZE FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100% IN PRIZES. You may cash only once in each category.
11. If bowling the Optional Doubles, multiple entries and multiple cashes are allowed, but may cash only once with the same partner. Singles scores are used for doubles.
12. **All players with scores in excess of 1100 must mail their verification of average form back to 20th Century within two weeks or their scores could be disqualified.**
13. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by any reason beyond the control of 20th Century Lanes shall cause all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with events up to that time.
14. **Last squad of Tournament Saturday, August 27, 2011.** Entries close Saturday, August 27, 2011.
15. **No Lima Bowlers the Final Weekend of the Tournament, August 27, 2011.**
